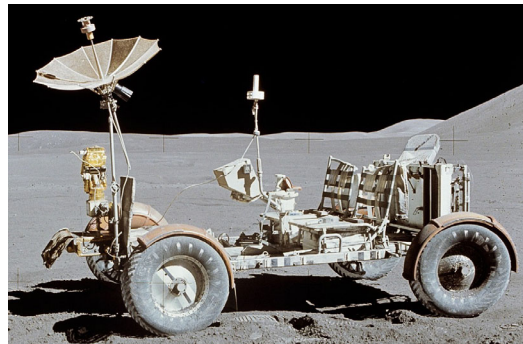
### Celebrating 50 Years!
