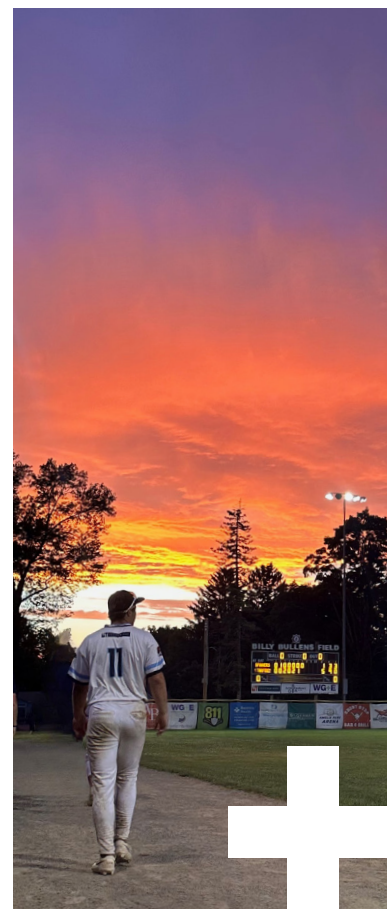

And the momentum keeps building. This June, Whip City Fiber welcomed its 19,000th customer. Serving residents and businesses across 20+ communities, this growth is a testament to our employees and the trust of the customers who rely on us every day.

We're also excited to announce that our Home Plus Program is now available citywide to all eligible Westfield homeowners. Previously offered only in select areas, Home Plus gives WG+E customers access to up to \$27,000 in funding for heat pump installations and qualified home efficiency improvements, including energy-efficient windows, exterior doors, and insulation.
